The pressurized spray is especially designed for use on horses and should not be used on meat and dairy animals. A wetting mist is delivered with a minimum of noise.

Holding can upright 12 to 18 inches from the animal, spray with short bursts, being careful to treat legs, belly, neck, back and sides. Cover eyes while spraying face or spray on sponge or cloth and apply to face as a wipe. Repeat treatment as necessary when flies are troublesome. Ceilings, walls and windows may also be sprayed to render them unattractive to flies.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

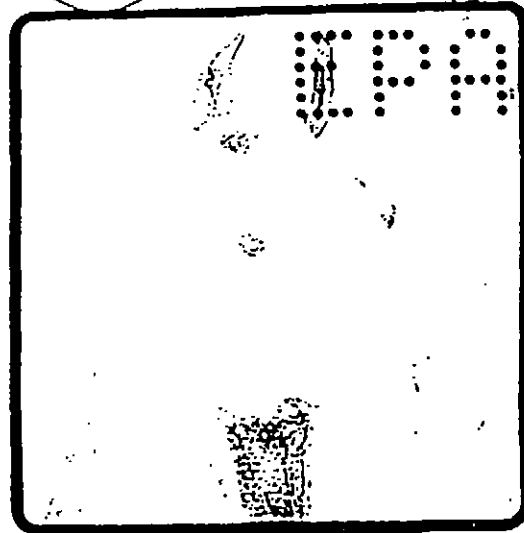
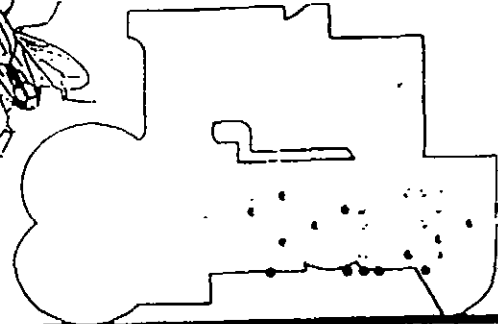
