Roaches, Flies, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Spiders, Cockroaches: Spray heavily into all cracks, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also spray on wall surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

Carpet Beetles: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where these insects may be found. Treat closets, cracks or closets and infested areas of clothing. Repeat as necessary.

Beetle Bug Fleas: Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floors and floor covering. Applications should be repeated as in bedbugs warrant and as infestation occurs. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following final treatment. Do not treat animals with this formulation.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, and Small Flying Moths (Giant): For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects might congregate.

Flies, Chiggers, Ants and Beetle Bug Ticks (Giant): For treatment of localized outdoor infestations spray weeds and non-crop vegetation in areas around the home. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as in bedbugs warrant and as infestation occurs.
