Subject: Amendment- Revise per Diazinon Registration Standard
Diazinon Crack & Crevice Insecticide
EPA Registration No. 9444-95
Your Submission dated April 27, 1992

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with a registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided the following revisions are made prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling:

1. Under Precautionary Statements: Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals

a. Add---Causes moderate eye injury---after the first sentence.

b. Add---Cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying--- after-----Keep children and pets off treated areas until spray has dried.

2. Under the Statement of Practical Treatment add---" Get medical attention" at the end of the statements for "If Inhaled" and "If on Skin".

3. Under " Environmental Hazards" revise the sentence to read -----Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes.

4. Add the word feed wherever food is mentioned e.g.

a. Applications within Food/feed Areas

b. Food/Feed Handling Establishments

5. Prior to the heading "Application Limited to Crack and Crevice Treatment Only" revise the Food Handling Establishments' section to read as follows:

Food and Feed Handling Establishments

a. Places other than private residences in which food or feed is held, processed, prepared or served (includes restaurants, canneries, bakeries, food/feed processing plants, mills, dairies, etc. This product may be used in the food/feed areas of these establishments)

- b. Revise Food Area to read Food/Feed Area
- 6. Revise the statement "Recommended for Commercial/Industrial Use" to read "For Commercial/Industrial Use Only".

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly after using and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of food, utensils, and food preparation areas. Keep children and pets off treated areas until spray has dried. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeated contact with skin. If sensitization reactions result, consult a physician. Do not apply this pesticide in patient rooms occupied by the elderly or infirm.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply to any body of water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not spray on plastic, painted or varnished surfaces or directly into any electronic equipment such as radios, televisions, computers, etc. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If Inhaled: Remove patient to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

CRACK & CREVICE INJECTION USE ONLY

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use as a space spray. This insecticide is for use only with injection tube and for injecting into cracks and crevices where insects may be hiding, living and breeding. Place injector tip 1/2 inch into cracks, crevices, holes and other small openings where insects may be a problem. Release approximately 1 second spray per shot. In serious infestations, if possible, place spots approximately 12 inches apart. In light infestations or preventative treatment, place spots approximately 3 feet apart. See the additional directions below for effective control of specified insects.

CRAWLING INSECTS: COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, SPIDERS, TICKS, EARWIGS, CRICKETS, SOWBUGS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES-Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, behind baseboards, coffee makers, meter boxes, and murals. Spray directly on insects in these locations where possible. Repeat as necessary.

BOOKLICE and SILVERFISH: Spray cracks and crevices in baseboards, doorframes, bookcases and storage areas. Spray directly on insects in these locations where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray into trails, nests, and points of entry around doors, windows, structural cracks and crevices. Spray directly on insects in these locations where possible. Repeat as necessary.

GRAIN WEEVILS, FLOUR BEETLES, CHOCOLATE MOTHS, DRUGSTORE BEETLES (in exposed adult and larval stages) and hibernating stages of **BOXELDER BUGS, ELM LEAF BEETLES, CLUSTER FLIES and CLOVER MITES:** Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks and crevices in wall voids, around windows and doorframes, under siding, in machinery and in dark secluded areas. Repeat as necessary.

Localized treatment of wood-destroying insects, CARPENTER ANTS, CARPENTER BEES-Locate source of infestation. Inject 5-10 second spray into insect tunnels and cavities. For **CARPENTER BEES**, seal entrance openings with small pieces of stainless steel wool after application.

APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Food Handling Establishments - Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREA - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY. Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) also would be considered a food area.

Apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, motor housing, junction boxes or switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where insects hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Applications of this product in the food areas of food handling establishments, other than as a crack and crevice treatment, are not permitted.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap, wrap empty container in newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
