The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment as follows:
 - a. Under If Swallowed, add "immediately" after "Get medical attention."
 - b. Add: "If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air and call a physician if effects occur."
2. Change "Physical Hazards" to "Physical or Chemical Hazards."
3. Add "Do not incinerate or puncture." to the Storage section.
4. Under Physical or Chemical Hazards add "Extremely Flammable" before "Contents under pressure."

5. Since your data matrix does not give a dielectrical breakdown voltage, you must add the following to the use directions:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

6. Revise the company name and address to reflect the change of ownership of this company number and product registration.

7. Change "Destroy old pet bedding..." to "Destroy pet's old bedding..."

The subject Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated May 5, 1989, which reflects the deletion of [REDACTED] from this formulation, is acceptable and has been made a part of the record for this product.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Physical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperature above 130°F may cause bursting.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy old pet bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.
