SAFETY STATEMENT

CAUTION

This product contains a strong solvent. The area after treatment of a completed account should be rinsed thoroughly with skin, eye or clothing. INFORMATION ON MEASURABLE HAZARDS

Acute Toxicity: LD₅₀ (oral) 100 mg/kg for rats. LD₅₀ (dermal) 100 mg/kg for rabbits. LD₅₀ (inhalation) 100 mg/l for rats. No evidence of carcinogenic effects.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL: Do not apply to food or food handling areas. Do not apply to areas where food or food handling areas are located. Do not apply to areas where food or food handling areas are located.

ANIMAL PESTS: DO NOT SPRAY INDOORS. Water bugs, fleas, ticks, cockroaches, ants, termites, carpenter ants, beetles, moths, carpet beetles, drug store beetles in exploded adult and larvae stages. Contact areas include carpets, walls, floors, trim, baseboards, door frames, window frames, ceiling joists, eaves, exterior walls, attics, excluded areas. For Carpet Beetles, treat under carpet, under furniture, around doors, baseboards, and exterior walls. For Drug Store Beetles, treat around doors, baseboards, and exterior walls. These pests may be found. Repeat treatments as necessary.

ANIMAL SEVERAL IN CHICKEN HOUSES: Close to roosting, display directed spray. Do not spray on food or food handling areas.

FAUNA: A light application may be applied to the exterior of buildings, areas often frequented recently travelled by the animal. Spray to give a greater coverage. To reduce reinestation, pet strand to be treated with registered flea and tick control products prior to re-entering treated premises. Spray entire interior surfaces of enclosures. Repeat as necessary, thoroughly spraying floors, bedding, cracks and crevices. Spray directly on more insects as possible.

FOOD PROCESSING AREAS OR FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS:

GENERAL: Apply a small amount of product directly to areas of concern. Do not allow product to come in direct contact with food, food containers, equipment bases, between equipment bases and the food, with voids, motor housing, junction boxes or switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where insect hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed tissue or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.
