Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals
CAUTION

Do not spray in eyes. Avoid contamination of food. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not start breathing by mouth to an unconscious person.
If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 for an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Flush skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
Have the product container (label) with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

Physical or Chemical Hazards: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

Sanitizes, deodorizes and refreshes the air. Reduces airborne bacteria and many virus particles. Minimizes danger of spreading germs and viruses through the air.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove protective cap from top of can and insert can into Dispenser in accordance with instructions on machine.

IMPORTANT: When used with the Automatic Dispenser, one unit should be installed for each 6,000 cubic foot area to be treated. It is usually advisable to mount the dispenser 7 feet from the floor and at a point where wind flow will carry the particles throughout the room.

This Air Sanitizer is engineered for highly effective use in Automatic Aerosol Dispensers. The Dispenser automatically actuates the special metered valve every fifteen minutes, treating the air against odors and providing effective air sanitization. Within 24 hours of continued use, this Air Sanitizer will prove highly effective in reducing strep, staph, other airborne bacteria and virus particles. One Dispenser is designed to treat a room up to 30' x 20' x 10'.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
