TIME-MIST INSECTICIDE is engineered for use in the TIME-MIST Automatic Aerosol Dispenser. The TIME-MIST Dispenser automatically actuates the special metered valve every fifteen minutes. Within 24 hours, the area is relatively free of flies, mosquitoes, gnats and with continued use reduces annoyance from them. One TIME-MIST Dispenser is designed to protect a room up to 30'x20'x10' for 30 days, 24 hours a day. TIME-MIST Insecticide contains 3,000 sprays when dispensed at a rate of 66 mg. per spray.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Remove protective cap from top of can and insert can into TIME-MIST Dispenser. Suspend Dispenser 7' from the floor and at a point where wind flow will carry the particles throughout the room.

CAUTION: Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged people are confined. Use 12 feet or more from exposed food or food handling or dispensing surfaces.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap, wrap container and put in trash collection.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.
