CAUTION**

Irritant if swallowed or inhaled. Causes moderate eye injury. Causes pulmonary edema. Do not induce vomiting because of aspirin-like properties in hazard. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and warm water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be removed or discarded.

Statement of Practical Treatment

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Flies, Fleas, Ticks, Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Crickets, Spiders, Small Flying Moths, Pillbugs, Silverfish, and Wasps.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning, close and lock-hanging equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Extinguish all flames including pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Pull valve opening away from face when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of a substructured area (12,000 cubic feet when using 12.64 oz), the additional units for rooms above or above free flow of what is not treated. Do not re-ventilate the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place cover on top of newspaper or pad on chair or on table in the center of the room. Pull valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, holding the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table or its valve locked open. Leave bedding at once and keep bedding clean for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in the areas or where necessary.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Remove pet's old bedding & replace with clean, fresh bedding a few treatments is required. Use product as above. Pets also should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises to prevent reinfestation.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not use near motor, heat, or flame by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap, wrap empty container in newspaper and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
