The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following label changes.

1. Delete the second set of instructions under the If Swallowed statements beginning with "immediately call a poison control center or doctor... Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by to an unconscious person.". This set of instructions contradict the correct set of instructions which appear at the beginning of the If Swallowed section.

You must submit two(2) final printed labels before you release the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For control of ticks, fleas and lice on dogs and cats, dilute 4 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin.

For control of ear mites, while dipping, lightly sponge inside of ears.

Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary.
