Dear Ms. Rohner:

The proposed amendment to the registration for the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act as amended revising the label by adding a claim for effectiveness against mosquitoes which may carry West Nile Virus is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

The referenced studies are sufficient for the preliminary acceptance of the requested label claim for mosquitoes including those that may transmit WNV. The following label language is acceptable:

"Kills and repels Flies, Mosquitoes [including Culex species] which/that may carry/transmit the West Nile Virus], Gnats and Small Flying Moths."

However, due to the unacceptable control mortalities observed in the latter study, confirmatory data are necessary. Corroborative data must be submitted or cited within 12 months of the date of this letter.

In addition the label claim, "Lasts 30 Days", must be deleted and replaced with, "Container lasts for up to 3 applications. Approximately 2.12 oz. (60g) is dispensed at each metered interval.". This determination is based upon information provided by you. Refer to the enclosed Efficacy review for details.

The label must also be revised as follows:

Delete the statement, "Authorized by USDA for Use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants.". USDA no longer reviews labeling or authorizes products for use in these plants.
