CAUTION

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FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN Food handling establishments, restaurants, hospitals, hotels, motels, stores, dairies, barns and food processing establishments where flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths and gnats are an annoyance.

[Product Name] contains a highly effective insecticide formulation especially designed for use in automatic metered dispensers. Exposed food should be covered prior to activation period of the dispenser.

FOR USE WITH Automatic Metered Dispensers: One dispenser unit should be installed for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space to be treated. Dispenser should be located at least 7 to 8 feet from floor. Set dispenser times for desired hour of activation. Insert aerosol. Put switch in "on" position. The Dispenser activates the metered valve once every 15 minutes. After one hour of operation, enough insecticide is suspended in the air to kill a substantial proportion of flies, mosquitoes, gnats, and moths present. If less than 24 hour control is required, the dispenser should be set to start one hour before control is desired and run one hour after control is no longer needed. Factors such as airflow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperature affect insect activity and control. Therefore, one unit per 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space should be considered as an average with adjustments made depending on specific conditions at usage site. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect prevention practices are followed.

It is suggested that the container be changed every 30 days.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool dry area away from children.

Disposal: Do not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
