The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following label changes.

1. In conjunction with your first aid statements, add the following precautionary statements to your product label to read:

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid breathing spray mists. Avoid contact with eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

If you disagree with these precautionary statements, please submit or cite acceptable studies to meet the Agency's acute toxicity data requirements. See 40 CFR 158.240.

2. With regards to the notification dated August 29, 2003 to add advisory language to the label, the Agency has no objection to the addition of the statement **"Use 12 feet or more from exposed food or food handling or dispensing surfaces"**. This statement should appear in the directions for use section rather than the precautionary statements.

CAUTION

FIRST AID

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not allow spray to contact plastic, painted or varnished surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN non-residential food handling establishments, commercial or institutional kitchens, dining areas and pantries of restaurants, supermarkets, food plants, food warehouses, bottling plants, hospitals, nursing homes, day-care centers, hotels, motels, stores, kennels, dairies, farms, barns, stables, milk and egg handling areas of dairies and chicken houses.

This product contains a highly effective insecticide formulation especially designed for use in automatic metered dispensers.

FOR USE WITH Automatic Metered Dispenser: One dispenser unit should be installed for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space to be treated. The Dispenser activates the metered valve once every 15 minutes. Effectiveness of this product will be noticeable within one hour after the Dispenser is activated. Recommended use is for 24 hour control; but if less than 24 hour control is required, the Dispenser should be set to start one hour before control is desired and run one hour after control is no longer needed. Factors such as airflow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperature affect insect activity and control. Therefore, one unit per 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space should be considered as an average with adjustments made depending on specific conditions at usage site. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect prevention practices are followed.

It is suggested that the container be changed once a month (when operated on a 24-hour basis).

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool dry area away from children.

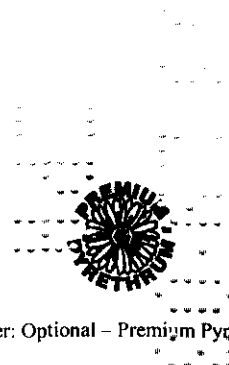
