The proposed amendment to the registration for the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act, as amended revising the label in accordance with PR Notices 2001-1 and 2001-6 is acceptable subject to the comment listed below.

Add the following statements to the Precautionary Statements:

"Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco."

A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the revised finished label before the product is released for shipment under this revised label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN food handling establishments, restaurants, hospitals, hotels, motels, stores, dairies, barns, and food processing establishments where flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths and gnats are an annoyance.

Purge 30 DS contains a highly effective insecticide formulation especially designed for use in automatic metered dispensers.

FOR USE WITH Automatic Metered Dispenser: One dispenser unit should be installed for each 3,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space to be treated. The Dispenser activates a 51 mg metered shot once every 15 minutes. Effectiveness of Purge 30 DS will be noticeable within one hour after the Dispenser is activated. Recommended use is for 24 hour control; but if less than 24 hour control is required, the Dispenser should be set to start one hour before control is desired and run one hour after control is no longer needed. Factors such as airflow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperature affect insect activity and control. Therefore, one unit per 3,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space should be considered as an average with adjustments made depending on specific conditions at usage site. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect prevention practices are followed.
