DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

This product will kill Fleas, Ticks, Aunts, Cockroaches, Crickets, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Rice Weevils, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, and Small Flying Mites. It will also prevent product fleas from developing into the adult biting stage up to 7 months (210 days).

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Turn out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where it is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, holding the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before re-entry. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS: Old bedding should be removed and replaced with fresh, clean bedding after treatment. Pets should be treated with a registered product for fleas and ticks control in conjunction with this treatment.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel aerosols can be recycled. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label. DO NOT REUSE. If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in the trash.
