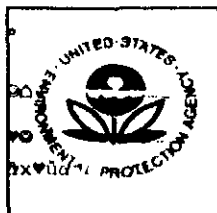

On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 9444-166".
- b. Add the following statement under the Directions for Use:

IMPORTANT! To avoid FLAMMABILITY HAZARDS use as follows:

- Only one can per room.
- Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table
- Shut off electrical equipment
- Place can at least 6 feet from pilot lights

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- c. Under Directions for Use move the section "Do not apply when food processing facility.....Do not treat establishments where livestock food is present" to the Directions for Use section.
- d. Under Directions for Use, delete "Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured" because this statement directly conflicts with "Use only one can per room."
- e. To assist the user in the understanding the appropriate room size, the statement should read, "Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling).
- f. Under IF SWALLOWED add: "Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol."

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye injury. Contains petroleum distillates. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and water after use. Prolonged or frequently repeated contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid consumption of food or beverages.

Do not apply when food processing facility is in operation or foods are exposed. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment before application. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in kitchen, avoid posting plates, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc., where exposed food will be handled as not be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Food areas include areas for receiving, storage, packaging (packing, boxing, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and cleaned processing systems (sinks, drains, cutting tables, dryers). Serving areas or a place where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but not including areas where food may be prepared or held. Non-food areas include entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, deep cleans and storage (after cleaning or bottling). Do not treat establishments where livestock feed is present.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard.  
IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.  
IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contains under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product will kill Cockroaches, Ants, Flies, Mosquitoes, Fleas, Ticks, Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Crickets, Spiders, Small Flying Moths, and Sowbugs.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open curtains and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Extinguish all flames including pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where true floor of wall is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or on table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place trigger on stand or table with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before exiting. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying as late weeks or when necessary.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean. Treat bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.

#### STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.  
STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in the free but growing number of communities where such service is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to its label. DO NOT PUNCTURE if recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in the trash.
