Dear Ms. Rohner:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Revise front of the label-- replace "Inert Ingredients" with the phrase"Other Ingredients".
- 2. Revise Precautionary Statements as follows:

"Harmful inhaled or absorbed through skin. Cause moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

3. Under the Precautionary Statement, move "Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying." to the

Direction for Use section

- 4. You may delete the If Swallowed first aid and Harmful if swallowed statement since the acute oral toxicity is in toxicity category IV. Based on the amount of petroleum distillates in the product you may also delete this statement under ingredient statement.
- 5. Under Precautionary Statements delete, "In case of contact flush with plenty of water." and "Obtain medical attention if irritation persists" since appropriate first aid instructions are already given under the First Aid section of the label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Shake Well Before Use.** This product will kill Cockroaches, Ants, Flies, Mosquitoes, Fleas, Ticks, Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Crickets, Spiders, Small Flying Moths, and Sowbugs. Do not apply when food processing facility is in operation or foods are exposed. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment before application. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of

Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.
