PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposel.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel serosol can recycling is awaitable.
