PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals
CAUTION

Avoid if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after use. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Flammable under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Contents in temperatures above 130°F may cause boiling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label.

Use in enclosed areas: exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets, drawers to be treated. Shut off air and air conditioning. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Fogger is opening away from you and eyes when releasing. Use one 9 oz. unit for each 9,000 cubic feet or one 1.02 oz. unit for 5000 cubic feet of unobstructed space. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in area during treatment, and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, and flip the switch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several sheets of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for one-half hour. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

Tick and Flea Control: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a labeled tick and flea control product prior to reentry. Repeat as necessary to bring infestation under control.

Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

Do not apply while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

Wash hands, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate area for two hours prior to returning patients.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

QUALITY: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

RECYCLING: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label. DO NOT PUNCTURE if recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in a trash.
