# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Avoid breathing of vapor. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. #### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FLYING INSECTS: House Files, Fruit Files, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths—Close all windows and doors and direct fog upward at a rate of 1-3 seconds per 1.000 cubic feet. Disperse in all locations, Keep area closed for 15 minutes.

**CRAWLING INSECTS: Cockroaches, Waterbugs**—Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

GRAIN WEEVILS, FLOUR BÉETLES, CHOCOLATE MOTHS, CARPET BEETLES, DRUGSTORE BEETLES in exposed adult and larval stage: Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks, crevices, stored products, machinery, and dark, secluded areas. For Carpet Beetles, treat infested areas of carpet, localized areas of floors, baseboards, and into cracks and under carpet where these pests may be found. Repeat treatment weekly or as insects appear.

ANTS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS: Hold aerosol close to cracks and spray directly into them contacting as many insects as possible. Apply freely in all possible hiding places behind baseboards, sinks, cabinets, coffee makers, meter boxes and manholes. Repeat at an excessary.

LEAS & TICKS: Treat pet's bedding, resting areas, walkways, and other areas heavily travelled by the animal. Spray to give adequate coverage. To reduce reinfestation, pets should be treated with registered flea and tick control products prior to reentering treated premises. Spray entire interior surfaces of doghouses. Repeat as necessary, thoroughly spraying floors, bedding, cracks and crevices. Spray directly on as many insects as possible.

#### APPLICATION WITHIN FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, motor housing, junction boxes or switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where insects hide.
