Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not use on plants. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs, or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils contaminated with this product. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. 1-2 ounces per head per day gives adequate protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine mist spray.

TO WIPE ON: First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulder, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often are seen.

Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin.

After application, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat.

Repeat daily or as required.

USE AS A SPRAY: This product may be applied as a fine mist spray to stable area and over and around stabled horses for fast paralysis and kill of flies. Do not wet horse's skin or exceed two ounces per application.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand, or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent onto a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour, or spill near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.
