DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violetion of Federal less to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its lebeling.

This product has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against files while imperting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out, 1-2 ourses per head per day gives adequate protection. Apply by either soft cioth or fine mist spray.

TO WIPE OR: Prof. brush enimal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of droping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing expessal the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulder, shanks, neck and factal areas where files most often are seen.

Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet sidn.

After explication, trush out thoroughly to tring out tricht sheen on the cost.

Recent daily or as required.

USE AS A SPRAY: This product may be applied as a line mist agray to stable area and over and around stabled horses for fast parabate and kill of files. Do not wet horse's akin or expend two ounces per application.
