

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
**Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals**  
**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not use on plants. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs, or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils contaminated with this product. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

**FIRST AID**

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.  
 If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.  
 If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.  
 If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.  
**HOT LINE NUMBER:** Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. For terrestrial use, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

**PHYSICAL HAZARDS**

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. 1-2 ounces per head per day gives adequate protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine mist spray.  
**TO WIPE ON:** First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulder, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often are seen.  
 Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin. After application, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat.  
 Repeat daily or as required.  
**USE AS A SPRAY:** This product may be applied as a fine mist spray to stable area and over and around stabled horses for fast paralysis and kill of flies. Do not wet horse's skin or exceed two ounces per application.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.  
**STORAGE:** If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand, or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent onto a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour, or spill near heat or open flame.  
**DISPOSAL:** If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

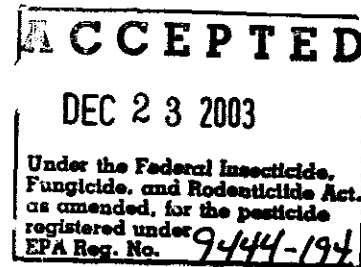
