This product is toold to fish, birds, and other wildliffs. PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against files while imperting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out, 1-2 ounces per head per day gives adequate protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine mist spray.

TO WIPE ON: First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulder, shanks, neck and factal areas where files most often are seen.

Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin,

After application, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the cost.

USE AS A SPRAY: This product may be applied as a fine mist spray to stable area and over and around stabled horses for test paralysis and kill of files. Do not wet horse's skin or exceed two ounces per application.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. STORABE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas, with generous amounts of ebsorbent metertal, such as clay, distantaceous earth, sand, or sawdust. Sweep the contami-nated absorbent onto a showler and put the sweepings the salvage drum. Dispose of westes as below. Place any isolating container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour, or spill neer head or open flame. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waster resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved
