This product will kill adult cockroaches and inhibits their natural ability to reproduce by
preventing nymphal cockroaches from becoming reproductive adults.

Remove cap at tip of barrel of the pre-filled, disposable syringe and apply paste only in ar-
eas not easily accessible to children and pets. Apply paste near aggregation and harbor-
ing areas. Apply behind and under the following: stoves, refrigerators, dishwashers,
sinks, counters, shelving, washing machines, tubs, waterpipes, around pipe collars,
drains, sewers, man holes, electrical boxes, cracks and crevices of baseboards, in cor-
ners of cupboards, cabinets and closets. Remove drawers from chests and cabinets,
apply freely into corners of drawer wells. Reapply every two to three months. All visible
paste should be packed into cracks and crevices. Remove excess paste and dispose into
garbage. Avoid contamination of food and feed stuff.

This product may not be used in Food Areas of Food Handling Establishments. Nonfood
Areas (including Some Serving Areas): Includes garbage room, lavatories, floor
drains (to sewer), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler
rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Also includes some
Serving Areas. Nonfood Serving Areas: Serving Areas are facilities where food is
served, such as dining rooms, but not where food is prepared or held. These areas are
considered Nonfood Areas when food is not exposed and the facility is not in operation.

pipes in areas such as garbage rooms, locker rooms, mop closets, boiler rooms, lavato-
ries, pantries and other areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.
