On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Decision, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. - NOTE: The new primary brand name "CB® Invader® II with Propoxur" has been noted in the Agency's records. All previously approved brand names containing the word "Residual" are now void.
- Under the Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals section, the following text may be deleted, as it appears in the PPE and User Safety Recommendations sections: "Personal protective equipment must include...socks." "Users should wash hands...Wash thoroughly after using."
- Delete the optional "Premium Pyrethrum" logo.
- NOTE: Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, the website then becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Personal protective equipment must include: long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, and shoes plus socks. Contact with skin, eyes or clothing should also be avoided. FIRST AID

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN- Atropine Sulfate is antidotal. Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Contains methyl carbamate that inhibits cholinesterase.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Applicators and all handlers must wear: Long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks and shoes and chemical resistant gloves made of barrier laminate, nitrile rubber, neoprene rubber, or viton. Follow manufacturer's requirements for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If there are no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

User Safety Recommendations: Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to wildlife and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not spray on plastic, painted or varnished surfaces or directly into any electronic equipment such as radios, televisions, computers, etc.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not contaminate food, utensils, and food preparation areas. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or indirectly. Keep people and pets out of the area during application.

This insecticide is for use only with injection tube and for injecting into cracks and crevices where insects may be hiding, living and breeding. Place injector tip ½ inch into cracks, crevices, holes and other small openings where insects may be a problem. Release approximately 1 second spray per spot. In serious infestations, if possible, place spots approximately 12 inches apart. In light infestations or preventative treatment, place spots approximately 3 feet apart. See additional directions below for effective kill of specified insects.

CRAWLING PESTS: Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Spiders (excluding black widow and brown recluse), Earwigs, Crickets, Sowbugs, and Millipedes-Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, behind baseboards, coffee makers, meter boxes and manholes. Spray directly on insects in these locations where possible. Repeat as necessary.

BOOKLICE & SILVERFISH: Spray cracks and crevices in baseboards, doorframes, bookcases and storage areas. Will only kill pests present at the time of application. Pests must be directly contacted to be effective. Contact as many pests

as possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS (excluding fire, harvester, carpenter, and pharaoh ants): Spray into nests, trails and points of entry around doors, windows, structural cracks and crevices. Will only kill pests present at the time of application. Pests must be directly contacted to be effective. Contact as many pests as possible. Repeat as necessary.

GRAIN WEEVILS, FLOUR BEETLES, CHOCOLATE MOTHS, DRUGSTORE BEETLES (in exposed adult and larval stages) and hibernating stages of BOXELDER BUGS, ELM LEAF BEETLES, CLUSTER FLIES and CLOVER MITES: Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks and crevices in wall voids, around windows and doorframes, under siding, in machinery, and in dark, secluded areas. Repeat as necessary.

For TERMITES: Inject 5-10 seconds spray into insect tunnels and cavities. This application is not a substitute for mechanical alteration, soil treatment or foundation treatment but is merely a supplemental treatment. For kill of aboveground termites in localized areas, apply to voids and galleries in damaged wood, and in spaces between wooden

mechanical alteration, soil treatment or foundation treatment but is merely a supplemental treatment. For kill of **above-ground termites** in localized areas, apply to voids and galleries in damaged wood, and in spaces between wooden structural members and between the sill plate and foundation where wood is vulnerable. Applications may be made to inaccessible areas by drilling, and then injecting with a void injector into the damaged wood or wall voids. Termite carton nests in building voids may be injected using a void injector. It is desirable to physically remove carton nest material from building voids when such nests are found. This type of application is intended to be a supplemental treatment for kill of drywood and above-ground subterranean termites and other wood-infesting insects. This product is intended to kill workers or winged reproductive forms which may be present in the treated areas.

APPLICATIONS IN AIRCRAFT: Do not use this product in aircraft cabins.

APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Limited to Crack & Crevice Treatment Only. Food handling establishments are places other than private residences where food is held, processed, prepared, or served. Food areas include areas for receiving, storage, packaging, preparing, edible waste storage, and enclosed processing systems. Apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, motor housing, junction boxes or switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where insects hide. Do not allow the product to be deposited onto exposed surfaces or introduced into the air. Do not contaminate food or food processing surfaces. Do not use in the serving/dining areas of restaurants. Applications of this product in the food areas of food handling establishments, other than as a crack and crevice treatment, are not permitted.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool dry area away from children.
