Dear Ms. Rohner:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

- 1. Delete "Farms" from the front panel. This is a vague use site, and could be implied to apply to any area on a farm, i.e. farm house, farm equipment, etc.
- 2. Modify your marketing claims to read Kills[& Repels] [Files &] Mosquitoes, [including the Culex species] [which may carry][the West Nile Virus].
  - Revise the directions for use as follows:

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with it labeling.

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Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics, do not spray at close range.

### "For Use on Animals:

Do not spray on sick animals. Do not spray directly towards animals's eyes. Do not treat dogs or cats.

Diary Cattle: Thoroughly spray entire animal from approximately 2 feet distance. Spot treat withers, shoulders and back where saliva accumulates from head tossing. Thoroughly wash teats before milking.

Beef Cattle: Thoroughly spray entire animal from approximately 2 feet distance. Repeat application daily. Horses and Ponies: Lightly mist over the back of horses and ponies from a distance of 2 feet. Repeat application daily.

Hogs and Swine: Spray directly over the back of hogs for 1-2 seconds per hog. Repeat applications daily.

For Use in Milking Parlors, Milk Rooms, Barnes, Horse Barns, Stables, Hog Houses, and Poultry Houses to kill or repel the listed insects:

When using this product in an enclosed area, remove animals before spray. Cover all feed, and water troughs. Close all windows and doors. Do not remain in treated area. After 15 minutes, ventilate treated area. Repeat application daily.

Milking Parlors and Milk Rooms: In Milking Parlors and Milk Rooms, cover all milking utensils and milk to prevent contamination from spray and dead or falling insects. Apply as a space spray upwards, spraying for 1-3 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space.

Beef Cattle Barn and Hog Barns: Spray at a rate of 1-2 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space.

Stanchion Barn Use: Walk behind animals and direct spray over backs, allowing 1 second per animal.

Poultry houses: Use only in empty poultry houses (when birds are not present).

Apply as a space spray upwards at a rate of 1-2 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet."

To Kill Mud Dauber and Wasps: Apply mist directly on insects and their nests from approximately 2 feet distance. Contacted insects will fly away from the spray. Applications should be made in late evening, when insects are at rest. Spray into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible.

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To kill fleas in pet kennels and catteries: Do not use this product to treat Dogs or Cats. Remove animals before spraying. Change litter and pet bedding before treatment. Close all doors and windows. Hold aerosol 36 inches above floor and direct spray towards floor and lower walls for 10 seconds per 100 square feet. Make sure that all floor areas are treated. Keep treated area closed for 15 minutes, then open and ventilate and allow surfaces to thoroughly dry before reoccupying. Retreat after 7 days.

To kill flies, gnats, mosquitoes outdoors: Spray be walking the length of the target area at 25 foot intervals while spraying downwind. This container treats up to one acre. Repeat treatment in 7 days."

4. Modify the "OUTDOOR GROUND APPLICATION" to read: Kills [& repels] [Files &] Mosquitoes, [including the Culex species] [which may carry] [the West Nile Virus].

In these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitues acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed with the efficacy review.

**STANCHION BARN USE:** Walk behind animals and direct spray over backs, allowing 1 seconds per animal. For most effective results, apply each morning.

**HORSE BARNS OR STABLES:** In horse and pony barns, close all window and doors. Spray at the rate of 1-2 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated area. After 15 minutes, ventilate the area. Repeat the application as necessary.

**ANIMAL USE:** For animal application, lightly mist over back of horses and ponies from a distance of 2 feet. Do not spray directly toward the animal's face or eyes. Repeat application daily or as necessary.

**HOG OPERATIONS:** In hog houses, close all doors and windows. Spray at the rate of 1-2 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated area. After 15 minutes, ventilate the area. Repeat the application as necessary.

**ANIMAL USE:** For animal application, direct spray over back of hogs and spray for 1-2 seconds per hog. Do not spray directly toward the animal's face or eyes. Repeat application daily or as necessary.

**POULTRY OPERATIONS:** Use only in empty poultry houses (when birds are not present). In poultry houses, close all windows and doors. Spray roosts, walls, nests, and cages thoroughly. Spray at the rate of 1-2 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate after treatment. Treat daily or as necessary.

**MUD DAUBER AND WASP NEST:** Spray mist directly on insects and their nests from approximately 2 ft. distance. Contacted insects will fly away from fog. Applications should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible.

**FLEAS:** General Volumetric Treatment: Hold aerosol 36" above floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walls at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq. ft. making sure that all floor areas are contacted. Change litter before application. Keep area closed for 15 minutes. Remove animals before spraying. Open and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment after 7 days or as necessary.

KENNELS AND CATTERIES: Remove animals before spraying. Ventilate after treatment is completed.

OUTDOOR GROUND APPLICATION: Flies, Gnats, and Mosquitoes, [including the Culex species] [which may carry] [that may carry] [that carry] [which carry] [and transmit] [the West Nile Virus] [including those that carry West Nile Virus], in open areas near buildings and in campgrounds. Best results are obtained when wind speed is five (5) MPH or less. Apply at a rate of 60-80 seconds per acre. Spray in wide swaths across area to be treated. Allow spray drift to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat treatment as necessary.

### STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
