On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is <u>conditionally</u> registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), provided you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
- 2. Make the following label changes:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 9444 200."
 - b. Amend information provided under STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center

IF IN EYES: Hole eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING: Take off contaminate clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

c. Under "TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS", include the statement, "Remove pets prior to treatment".

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- d. Delete the word "Exterminator". Words claiming complete control are unacceptable. Also the term "Home" in product names is misleading since the product is for use at industrial and institutional sites also. Either delete or revise.
- e. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE, delete "Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured". This statement is in conflict with not using more than one fogger per room.
- f. Put an asterisk above schools on front panel and add below, "*Do not use in schools when open".
- g. The paragraphs beginning "Do not apply directly to food..." and "Remove pets, birds and cover...etc." should be moved under DIRECTIONS FOR USE. Also modify the last sentence in first paragraph to read, "Non-food/feed areas of commercial food/feed handling establishments where the product can be used are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories...etc.".
- h. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE, add "Not for use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants".
- i. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE, revise the sentence, "Cover exposed food, dishes and food handling equipment" to read, "In the home cover or remove food, dishes and food handling equipment".
- j. The retreatment statements should include a maximum frequency of application, such as: "... but not more than ____ times per __." Amend statement accordingly under TO OPERATE VALVE.

- 3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
- 4. Submit a revised data matrix which incorporates reference of the efficacy studies you are citing to support the label claims for public health pests (mosquitoes, flies, cockroaches, ticks, and fleas). You should check with MGK in this regard.
- 5. Submit a new Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) with the names/addresses of the inert ingredient suppliers.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.



Turn off ALL Ignition sources and it lights (that off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, the provided and it is your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 [5,000] [4,000] cubic first of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

* TO OPERATE VALVE: .To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the eatch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat operating in two weeks or when necessary.

OR

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the cotch. [break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Titt sprayer away from face (container sprays straight up). Press down firmly on sprayer pad until it chaps into place.)

To Kill Fleas and Ticks: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
