- 3. You must submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

Waterbury Companies, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's RED for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps and Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate after treatment. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Centipedes, and Sowbugs: General Volumetric Treatment– Open cabinets and doors in area to be treated. Shut off air conditioners, fans, and close doors and windows before spraying. Spray for 20 seconds per 1000 cubic feet of space (for 15 lb.size: 10 seconds per 1000 cubic feet). Direct spray toward areas suspected of harboring insects. Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, molding and floors. Repeat as necessary.

VOLUMETRIC TREATMENT FOR INACCESSIBLE VOIDS (Attics, False Ceilings, Wall and Equipment Voids): For crack and crevice application, calculate void volume in cubic feet. Treat 20 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Repeat as necessary...

FOOD PROCESSING PLANT USE: To kill Cockroaches, Spiders, Silverfish, Wasps, Hornets, Crickets—Spray the insect directly when possible. Spray all probable hiding places such as cracks, crevices, baseboards, sinks, cabinets, shelves, under appliances, in food storage areas. **To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths**—Close all windows and doors. Direct spray upward, spraying for 2-3 seconds for 1,000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate after treatment.

HOME USE: To kill Cockroaches, Spiders, Silverfish, Wasps, Hornets, Crickets–Spray the insect directly when possible and spray all probable hiding places such as cracks, crevices, baseboards, sinks, cabinets, shelves and under appliances. Repeat as necessary.—

Note, when using this product in an enclosed area, such as milkroom, barn or stable, remove animals before spraying. **DAIRY FARM USE: Milking Parlor and Milkroom**–Close all windows and doors. After spraying, milking utensils must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse.
