- 2. Make the following change(s) to the label:
 - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 9444-238"
 - b. Make the following label revision(s):

General Comment:

1. Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough."

Efficacy Review comment(s):

- 2. The efficacy (product performance) data originally submitted for EPA Reg. No. 9444-158, were found inadequate to support this application. Confirmatory data were required to be submitted for EPA Reg. No. 9444-158 by July 26, 2006. To date, these data have not been submitted and were subsequently reclassified as deficient.
- 3. Throughout the proposed label, delete all references to "Flies," "Mosquitoes," "Flying Insects," and "Mosquitoes [including Culex species], which/that may carry/transmit the West Nile Virus." The submitted efficacy (product performance) data do not support use of this product on these sites.
- 4. Since all public health pests must be removed from the proposed label, you may also want to delete the statement that the "Container lasts for up to 3 applications..."

Optional Marketing Claims comment(s):

5. Delete the 2nd and 3rd optional marketing claims for the reasons stated in Items 2, 3 and 4 above.

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals section comment(s):

6. Revise to read: "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

First Aid section comment(s):

7. Revise the existing "HOT LINE NUMBER subsection to read: "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. For additional information on this product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call (985) 878-6751, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. CST. After 4:30 p.m. CST, call your poison control center. For product information, you may call (203) 597-1812, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. EST."

Environmental Hazards comment(s):

8. To facilitate inclusion of language from the REDs for pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide, insert the following new section immediately preceding the "Physical or Chemical Hazards" section as follows:

"This product is toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Drift and run-off may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. This product may contaminate water through run-off. This water has a potential for run-off for several weeks after application. Poorly draining soils and soils with shallow water tables are more prone to produce run-off that contains this product.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.

Do not apply to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash-waters or rinsate. See Directions for Use for additional precautions and restrictions."

Directions for use section comment(s):

9. To facilitate inclusion of language from the REDs for pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide, add the following new subsection in its own text box immediately following the statement "It is a violation of Federal law ..." as follows:

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS & USE RESTRICTIONS

- Apply this product only as specified on this label.
- Do not contaminate of food or feedstuffs.
- Do not enter or allow others to enter until vapors, mists and aerosols have dispersed, and the area has been thoroughly ventilated.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift
- Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors and/or mists have dispersed.
- Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application.
- Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces, or wash them
 before use.
- For indoor food handling/processing facilities: Do not make space spray applications when facility is in operation. During space spray applications, cover or remove exposed food. During space spray applications, cover food processing surfaces or clean after treatment with a suitable detergent, rinse with potable water before use. Do not apply more than 1 time per day.
- For metered release devices: Not for use in residential areas. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where
 infants, ill or aged persons are confined. Do not place metering device directly over or within 8 feet of
 exposed food, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food handling or preparation. Do not install
 within 3 feet of air vents. Carefully follow directions for the dispenser unit and when replacing cans or
 conducting maintenance.
- For agricultural premises, and commercial animal housing and equipment: Do not apply more than 1 time per day.
- When used in dairy barns or facilities: Close milk bulk tank lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milking utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking.

On the 2nd line of the 1st paragraph starting with "FOR USE IN [ON] Food handling and ...," replace the words "(cargo area)" with the words "(cargo area only)" and delete the following use sites: "schools," "hospitals," "nursing homes" and "day-care centers," since the RED for pyrethrins prohibits the use of metered release devices on these use sites.
- 11. In the last sentence of the 2nd paragraph starting with "This product is engineered ...," replace the word "control" with the word "kill."

Storage & Disposal section comment(s):

- 12. Revise the subsection title currently labeled as "Storage:" to read: "Pesticide Storage:"
- 13. To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-4, replace the "Disposal:" subsection with: "Container Disposal: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Offer for recycling, if available. If partially filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions."

Conditional Data Gaps:

- 14. No data were submitted by the registrant for guideline 830.1600 (description of materials used to produce the product). The registrant is required to submit the MSDS sheets for all the chemicals used to formulate the proposed product.
- 15. No data were submitted by the registrant for guideline 830.1800 (enforcement analytical method). The registrant is required to provide a validated analytical method to assay the active ingredients in the proposed product. This is a product-specific data requirement and must be submitted along with analytical results and the representative chromatograms.
- 16. Within one (1) year from the date of approval of this label amendment, Waterbury Companies, Inc. is obligated to submit a One Year Storage Stability (830.6317) study and a Corrosion Characteristics (830.6320) study on this product in support of this registration. ¹

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3. You must submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

Waterbury Companies, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's RED for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). In addition, EPA's RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide

Should Waterbury Companies, Inc. wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under section 12(a)(1)(E) of FIFRA. 40 CFR §156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not be substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. FOR USE IN Food service and preparation areas, food processing plants, restaurants, clubs, stores, supermarkets, bottling plants, warehouses, buildings, factories, offices, laboratories, lavatories, ships, planes (cargo areas), hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, day care centers, funeral homes, kennels, farms, barns, stables, dairies, homes, milk and egg handling areas of dairies and chicken houses.

This product is engineered for use in automatic metered dispensers. The dispenser automatically activates the special metered valve every 15 and/or 30 and/or 45 minutes. Within 24 hours the area is relatively free of flies, mosquitoes, gnats, and small flying moths and with continued use reduces annoyance from them. Effectiveness of this product will be noticeable within one hour after the Dispenser is activated. Recommended use is for 24 hours: but if less than 24 hour use is required, the Dispenser should be set to start one hour before control is desired and run one hour after control is no longer needed. Factors such as airflow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperature affect insect activity and control. Therefore, one unit per 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space should be considered as an average with adjustments made depending on specific conditions at usage site. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect prevention practices are followed.

Do not use in aircraft cabins. It is suggested that the container be changed once a month.

OPERATION: Remove protective cap from top of can and insert can in dispenser. Suspend dispenser 7 feet from the floor and at a point where wind flow will carry the particles throughout the room.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
