3. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:


- a) Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 9444-240"
- b) Change '130Fs' to '130°F' in the "Physical or Chemical Hazards" section directions.
- c) For fire ant mound applications outdoors the cited 'me-too' product was conditionally registered with the requirement that the product must be applied in end-use containers of 6 oz. or greater. Your product application states that the container size is only 5 oz. and is therefore not efficacious against fire ants. Remove the directions for "Fire Ant Application" from the label.
- d) Change 'Storage' to read "Pesticide Storage" in the "Storage and Disposal Statement".
- e) Change 'Disposal' to "Container Disposal" and add "Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain." to the container disposal directions.

4. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated March 11, 2009 is acceptable and is the CSF of record.

5. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Shake Well Before Use. This product will kill Cockroaches, Ants, Flies, Mosquitoes, Fleas, Ticks, Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Crickets, Spiders, Small Flying Moths, and Sowbugs. Do not apply when food processing facility is in operation or foods are exposed. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment before application. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Food areas include areas for receiving, storage, packaging (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas are places where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but not excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Non-food areas include entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling). Do not treat establishments where livestock feed is present. Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Extinguish all flames including pilot lights. **IMPORTANT!** To avoid **FLAMMABILITY HAZARDS** use as follows: **DO NOT** use more than one fogger per room. **DO NOT** use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets, or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 25' x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling). Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building

closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.

[OUTDOOR USE ONLY]

[Fire Ant Application: Before placing the Fire Ant Housing over the mound, activate the mound by disturbing the mound with a digging tool (stick, spade, ax, knife, etc.). Quickly place the Fire Ant House (bucket, canopy, box) over the mound so that it covers a majority of the ant mound and engage lever mechanism to discharge the aerosol. Back away from Fire Ant Housing while aerosol evacuates and leave undisturbed for 15 minutes. Keep children and pets away until treated area is dry.]

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool dry area away from children.
