- b. Make the following label revision(s):

General Comment:

1. Delete all text throughout the label marked with "~~strikethrough~~."

Efficacy Review comment(s):

2. Efficacy-related claims on the proposed label are acceptable.
3. This product is being registered during a time period during which data is being submitted by other registrants for all existing products containing pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide and MGK® insecticide synergist (for product reregistration). Waterbury Companies, Inc. will also have to submit (or cite) data to support the efficacy-related claims on this new registration. At the appropriate time, the Agency will call in efficacy data for this product, and it will not be adequate to cite labels that were approved prior to product reregistration, as was done for this application. The Agency's Pesticide Re-evaluation Division is keeping track of all new pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide and MGK® insecticide synergist product registrations during this interim period, to ensure that all efficacy data requirements have been adequately fulfilled for all pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide and MGK® insecticide synergist registrants.

Ingredient Statement comment(s):

4. Revise the ingredient "Piperonyl Butoxide" to read "\*Piperonyl Butoxide, Technical."
5. Add a 2<sup>nd</sup> asterisk immediately preceding the ingredient "\*\*\*N-Octyl Bicycloheptene Dicarboximide."
6. Revise "INERT INGREDIENTS" to read "OTHER INGREDIENTS."
7. Add the following text as a new 1<sup>st</sup> footnote immediately preceding the existing footnote: "\*Equivalent to 0.80% (butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.20% of related compounds."
8. Add a 2<sup>nd</sup> asterisk immediately preceding the existing footnote, which will now appear as the 2<sup>nd</sup> footnote in this section.

9. Replace the 4<sup>th</sup> sentence with: "Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."

First Aid section comment(s):

10. Revise the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence within the existing "HOT LINE NUMBER subsection to read: "For additional information on this product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call (985) 878-6751, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. CST. 11. To facilitate inclusion of language from the REDs for pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide and MGK® 264 insecticide synergist, add the following new subsection in its own text box immediately following the statement “It is a violation of Federal law ...” as follows:

14. Revise the subsection title currently labeled as “Storage:” to read: “Pesticide Storage:”

15. To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-4, replace the “Disposal:” subsection with: “**Container Disposal:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **If empty:** Offer for recycling, if available. **If partially filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.”

3. You must submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

Should Waterbury Companies, Inc. wish to add/retain a reference to the company’s website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency.
