DIRECTIONS FOR USING BLEACH . . .

FOR MACHINE WASHING: Top-loading automatic and wringer washers . . . 1 cup bleach per load. Front-loading automatics . . . $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per load. Add bleach with detergent before immersing clothes or dilute bleach in one quart of water and pour in at wash cycle.

FOR HAND WASHING: Add 1 tablespoon bleach per gallon of water before clothes are added.

FOR DIAPERS: Flush out diapers. Pre-soak with 1 tablespoon bleach per gallon of water. Then launder according to directions above.

FOR REMOVING STUBBORN STAINS: Mix 2 tablespoons bleach for each quart of cold water. Soak entire stained item 5 to 15 minutes. Rinse well in clean water. Repeat once or twice if necessary.

DO NOT USE ON UNFAST COLORS, SILK, WOOL, LEATHER, OR ON NATURAL SPONGE.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN EATING ESTABLISHMENTS: (1) Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible. (2) Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner. (3) Rinse with clean water. (4) Sanitize in a solution of $\frac{1}{2}$ ounce to each gallon water (200 ppm). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code. (5) Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry. Note: A clean potable water rinse following sanitization is not permitted under Section H 96.16 (2) (c) 2 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. If taken internally by accident, drink milk and immediately call physician. Avoid full strength on skin. May cause severe skin and eye irritation. If spilled in eyes, wash eyes immediately with cold water.
