



DIRECTIONS FOR USING BLEACH ...

FOR MACHINE WASHING: Top-loading automatic and wringer washers ... 1 cup bleach per load. Front-loading automatics ... $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per load. Add bleach with detergent before immersing clothes or dilute bleach in one quart of water and pour in at wash cycle.

FOR HAND WASHING: Add 1 tablespoon bleach per gallon of water before clothes are added.

FOR DIAPERS: Flush out diapers. Pre-soak with 1 tablespoon bleach per gallon of water. Then launder according to directions above.

FOR REMOVING STUBBORN STAINS: Mix 2 tablespoons bleach for each quart of cold water. Soak entire stained item 5 to 15 minutes. Rinse well in clean water. Repeat once or twice if necessary.

DO NOT USE ON UNFAST COLORS, SILK, WOOL, LEATHER, OR ON NATURAL SPONGE.
