DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For general food plant cleaning use ½ to 1 ounce by weight per gallon of water, followed by a potable water rinse prior to use. For sanitizing and deodorizing, surfaces being cleaned should have a minimum contact time of two minutes where the sanitizing process consists of flowing over or through or by immersion in a one ounce per gallon of water solution for 200 ppm available chlorine.
