4. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year in storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity, using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this Registration Notice.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIRECTIONS**

USE ONLY IN A WELL VENTILATED AREA. REMOVE BIRDS. COVER AQUARIUMS BEFORE SPRAYING. REMOVE SAFETY CAP AND INSERT SPRAYER.

**CATS AND DOGS:** Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm fast strok get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears, and chest until damp. With finger rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs rub your hand against lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

**PUPPIES AND KITTENS:** Treat same as cats and dogs except nursing pups and kittens, spray only along back or on your arm, or legs and rub in with your lips.

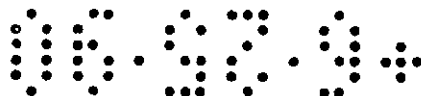
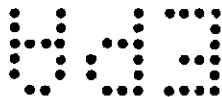
**PET SLEEPING QUARTERS:** Spray around baseboards, windows, frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The bedding should be sprayed and then replaced with fresh bedding for best results.

**HORSES:** To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies on face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these. Repeat treatment as needed.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate food or foodstuffs by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.
