

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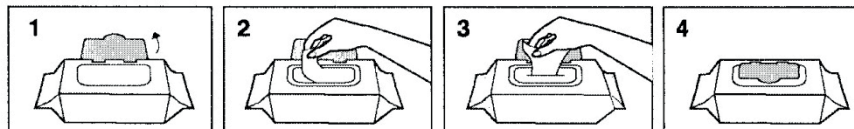
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Soft pack/Flow pack/Ecopak/Portable pack]

TO DISPENSE [TOWELETTES] [or WIPES] [or TOWELS] [or CLOTHS]: Open package lid. [Completely remove inner seal.] [or Press and peel back.] Pull out wipe. [(The next wipe pops up automatically.)] Snap lid closed after use to retain moisture.



[Bulk Pack/Bulk Flex Pack/ Bulk Eco Pak]

TO DISPENSE [TOWELETTES] [or WIPES] [or TOWELS] [or CLOTHS]: Open package lid. Push down around [the] ring area to break the seal and then pull on [the] ring to completely remove inner seal. Align [the] opening in the lid to the center of the wipe roll, remove first wipe for use, then thread next wipe through the hole in the packaging lid. To secure wipe, pull wipe down into small opening. Dispense single wipes as necessary by pulling out at an angle through the small opening. Allow surface to remain visibly wet for two (2) minute[s]. Use additional [or enough] wipe(s) [, if needed,] to ensure [continuous] two (2) minute[s] visibly wet contact time. Special Instructions for cleaning prior to disinfection against *Candida auris*:

Personal protection: Wear appropriate barrier protection such as gloves, gowns, masks, and eye coverings [per facility protocol].

Cleaning procedure: Fecal matter/waste must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces/objects before disinfection by application with [product name] [this product]. Precleaning is to include vigorous wiping and/or scrubbing and all visible soil is removed. Surfaces in patient rooms are to be cleaned in an appropriate manner, such as from right to left or left to right, on horizontal surfaces, and top to bottom, on vertical surfaces, to minimize spreading the organism. To disinfect [and decontaminate] prior to high-level disinfection [or HLD]: [Pre]clean gel from external surface of ultrasound transducer, scope[and] [or] probe by using a clean washcloth or [germicidal] wipe. Then, follow instructions to disinfect.
