
The re-submission referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, which provides a final printed Master Label which incorporates the required label changes listed in the EPA letter dated 11/3/03, is acceptable providing you re-submit three copies of the final printed label within 90 days from the date of this letter, which makes the following label changes. These final required changes were either overlooked or new to the label.

Page 3/12

- 1. For the two stand alone virus claims "[Virucidal*]" and "[...bacteria, and viruses*]", add to each the two tested viruses the Agency found the product effective against.
- 2. Delete "Greater" in "Greater quaternary dispersal...". This is an unqualified and unsubstantiated claim (ie., it's not clear what it is greater than).
- 3. Add "Common household germs" to "...help[s] control common household germs on treated surfaces...".
- 4. Globally delete the optional claim brackets around "[between treated surfaces]". "Cross contamination" cannot be separated from "[between treated surfaces]".

- 1. Delete or qualify the "% larger" in the claim "[New, (number)% larger towels]". Qualify as to what they are larger than.
- 2. Add "common" to the last claim "[Disinfects common household kitchen and bathroom bacteria]"

In the hospital and health care settings section, delete or qualify the unqualified and general use sites for surfaces made of "stainless steel, Formica, glass". These are not acceptable when listed alone and must be related either to specific uses, or related to existing uses listed on the label using revised wording (eg., "uses listed on this label consisting of stainless steel, Formica, and glass").
