The efficacy data (under review) you submitted to support the food contact use sites and associated organisms listed on the attached label, using the testing requirements outlined in the "Draft Interim Guidance for Non-Residual Sanitization of Hard Inanimate Food Contact Surfaces Using Pre-Saturated Towelettes", and the data (under review) you submitted for each organism intended for non-food contact use sites using DSS/TSS #10, are found fully acceptable.
- 3. You must make the changes listed below to the "Master Label" (your version dated 3/26/03), and submit three copies of a final printed "Master Label" within 60 days of the date on this notice.

A. The label uses brackets around "[Total....100.0000%]" indicating that this is an optional statement. The Agency will accept brackets on an interim basis providing: (1) you submit acceptable supporting evidence that "...labeling would include 'total' where there was room but that some labels are small and PDI needs to have the option of leaving it off ...", and (2) that you are not deleting this statement simply to make room and space for optional marketing claims or other optional words.

- B. The boxes at the bottom of each page enclose identical "label reader rules" that are not intended to be on final labels. You must make the following global changes to each of these boxes:
 - 1. Delete "top" from the first boldfaced line as there are no top boxes for reader rules.
 - 2. Change "The terms 'Wipe(s)', 'Towel(s)', and 'Cloth(s)' can be used interchangeably throughout", to the following, "The terms 'Wipe(s)', 'Towel(s)', and 'Cloth(s)' can be used interchangeably throughout except for the product primary brand name which can be only changed by notification or amendment."
 - 3. Change "List of items can be used partially or in their entirety", to, "List of uses and use sites can be used partially or in their entirety. Any individual statement, claim, restriction or other wording must be used in its entirety, and can not be expanded or shortened by combination, partial deletion, merging, or similar".
- C. On page 2/5, under "Food Contact Surfaces", change "Thoroughly preclean all food contact surfaces following required methods using suitable detergents, brushes, sponges and any other necessary equipment prior to rinsing and sanitizing with Sani-Wipe[...]", to "Thoroughly preclean all food contact surfaces following required methods using suitable detergents, brushes, sponges and any other necessary equipment. Then rinse with potable water and sanitize with Sani-Wipe[...]". This clarifies that rinsing is not with the product itself.
- 4. To clarify and resolve concerns with small size labels not having space for a "Total" statement (requirement 4A above), during the time-limited duration of this product, you must submit two copies of actual full color production labels for small product sizes that you intend to put into the marketplace.

5. The required label changes listed herein and the submitted data referenced in item #2 above, must be found to be fully acceptable for EPA to change the "Terms of Issuance" of this registration. If any of the submitted data are found to be not acceptable, you will be required to delete the affected portions of the label. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of all conditions listed herein.
