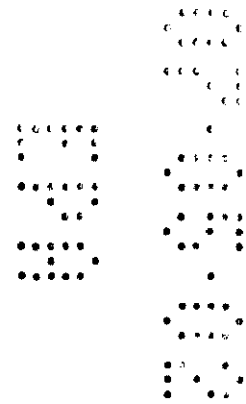

## KILLS OXALIS AND SPURGE IN DICHONDRA LAWNS

Water the lawn the day before use. Do not water again for at least 24 hours. Be sure foliage is dry at time of application. OXALIS/SPURGE X will not work at temperatures below 72°. Above 80°, at time of use, may cause severe temporary damage to dichondra foliage. Bladegrass lawns can tolerate this up to 95°. Tip burn will usually recover in a week or two. It can be used on young dichondra. Do not use in new bladegrass lawns until at least three mowings. It will not prevent seeds from germinating. If possible, weeds should be killed before they go to seed, thus reducing future infestations. Do not apply immediately after mowing. Wait for new growth to the lawn and weeds before use. Works best in sunlight rather than shade or cloudy conditions.

### A CONCENTRATED FOLIAGE SPRAY THAT KILLS OXALIS AND SPURGE

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE – Cont'd

1. Mix 4 oz. per gallon of water per 100 square feet of area to be treated. The addition of a good spreader-sticker is recommended. Apply to dichondra lawns when temperatures are in the mid-seventies. Bladegrass lawns up to 95°.
2. Use pressure type tank sprayer. Hose-end garden sprayers or water cans are not effective and should not be used. Leaves must be thoroughly saturated.
3. Repeat as necessary every 10 days to two weeks. If you do get regrowth, repeated treatments will cause the roots to die.

Clean spray equipment after use with clear water.


On behalf of National Chelating we are submitting a notification to change the primary brand name from Spurge X to Oxalis/Spurge X. This change is being made per PR-Notice 98-10. This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR-Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR-Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

The alternate brand name, Oxalis X, will no longer be used since the two names are being combined to create one product name. No other changes are being made at this time. To facilitate the change of the primary brand name an amended label (3 copies) and a complete application are enclosed.
