**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Initial Dose: 1 gallon CHEM-GONE to 50,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dose: 1 quart CHEM-GONE to 50,000 gallons of water.

Initial Dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after the killed algae are removed from the pool.

Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of CHEM-GONE for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week.

When the swimming season is over, add 1 gallon of CHEM-GONE to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

Maintenance Dose: Eight fluid ounces per 25,000 gallons of water. *0.5 pp*

Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.
