

HOW TO USE SANA-KLEAN

TO CLEAN & DISINFECT
TOILET BOWLS---First re-
move most of the water
from the bowl by forcing
it over the trap, using
an applicator, with a
plunger-like motion.
Pour SANA-KLEAN onto the
applicator. Thoroughly
clean inside and outside
surfaces of the fixture,
especially under the in-
side rim where the water
outlets are located. Flush
the bowl. Rinse applicator
in this clear water, and
rinse entire fixture.

TO CLEAN & DISINFECT
URINALS---Pour SANA-KLEAN
on applicator and clean
entire surface, especially
behind and under the in-
side lips where the water
outlets are located. If
urinal has a removable
screen or strainer, re-
move same. Pour three
ounces of SANA-KLEAN a-
round edges of drain
outlet so that it runs
down the side of the drain
pipe. Swab the inside of
the drain pipe. Flush.
Rinse entire fixture with
clear water. Replace screen
or strainer.

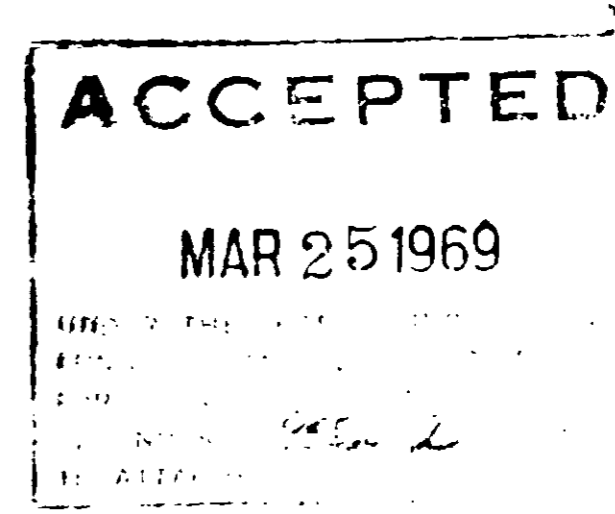
