DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE IN HOTELS; MOTELS; HOMES; NON-FOOD AREAS OF INSTITUTIONS, PACKAGING AND PROCESSING PLANTS; SEED HOUSES AND HORSE STABLES.

NOTE: Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils.

SPACE SPRAY: To kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats: Close room or area to be treated. Shut off air conditioner and ventilator system. Seal all open vents. Remove fish and pets. Apply undiluted as a very fine mist space spray through manually operated equipment or with electrical and other powered applicators. Avoid staining by holding the spray nozzle at least five feet from objects. Direct the fine spray mist toward the upper corner of the room. Fill the room with a fine mist space spray at the rate of 5 fluid ounces per 5,000 cubic feet. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy insects.

CONTACT SPRAYS: To kill roaches, ants, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes:

Adjust sprayer to produce large wetting type spray particles. Direct spray to contact these insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets and other harborages. Spray these infested areas until thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray doors around window frames, ant trails and hills.

TO KILL GRAIN INSECTS: Adults of confused flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles:

Remove infested grain cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in areas by removing before spraying. Spray directly on exposed stages and into cracks and crevices where grain insects may be hiding. In homes, dispose of all infested products. The shelves and drawers should be cleaned and thoroughly sprayed so as to contact all pests and covered with shelf paper after allowing shelves to dry. Any utensils that are contacted with spray should be washed before using. Repeat as necessary.

AYS: To kill roaches, rain mites, sowbugs, centipedes:

Use large wetting type spray pat-
tern to contact these insects in cracks and
crevices, around pipes, behind
boards, around pipes, behind
boards. Spray these infested
areas. Repeat as necessary.

S: Spray directly on these pests to reach the webbing and all other harbor spiders.

Spray doors, around window
frames.

INSECTS: Adults of beetles, saw-toothed and shiny spider beetles:

Use meal or flour and destroy. Avoid
food and foodstuffs in areas by
