

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE IN HOTELS; MOTELS; HOMES; NON-FOOD AREAS OF INSTITUTIONS; PACKAGING AND PROCESSING PLANTS; SEED HOUSES; IN HORSE STABLES (NOT FOR APPLICATION IF HORSES WILL BE USED FOR FOOT)

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

SPACE SPRAY: To kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats: Close room or area to be treated. Shut off air conditioner and ventilator system. Seal all open vents. Remove fish and pets. Apply undiluted as a very fine mist space spray through manually operated equipment or with electrical and other powered applicators. Avoid staining by holding the spray nozzle at least five feet from objects. Direct the fine spray mist toward the upper corner of the room. Fill the room with a fine mist space spray at the rate of 3 fluid ounces per 5,000 cubic feet. Let the room stand for one half hour. Ventilate thoroughly, but do not sweep up and destroy insects.

CONTACT SPRAYS: To kill roaches, ants, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes:

Adjust sprayer to produce large wetting type spray particles. Direct spray to contact these insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets and other harborage. Spray these infested areas until they are wet. Repeat as necessary.

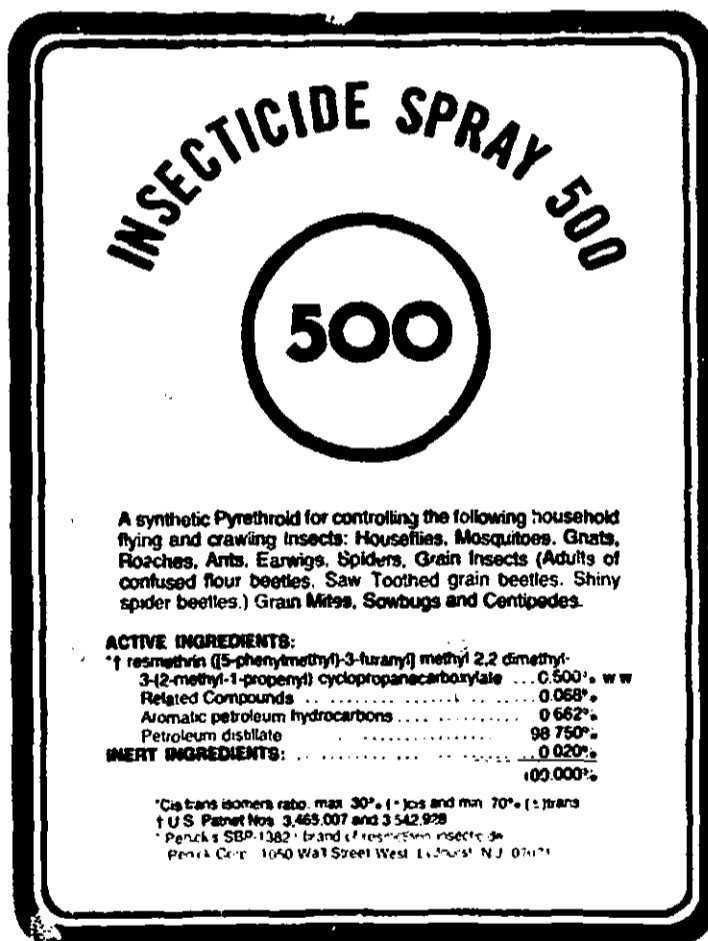
TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray floors around window frames, door thresholds, etc.

TO KILL GRAIN INSECTS: Adults of confused flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles:

Remove infested grain cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in areas by removing before spraying. Spray directly on exposed stages and into cracks and crevices where grain insects may be hiding. In homes, dispose of all infested products. The shelves and drawers should be cleaned and thoroughly sprayed so as to contact all pests and covered with shelf paper after allowing shelves to dry. Any utensils that are contacted with spray should be washed before using. Repeat as necessary.
