Subject: Revised Labeling
Pro Kill Roach & Ant Pressurized Spray
EPA Registration No. 9591-92
Your Letter Dated January 30, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable subject to the conditions listed below.

1. In your "Directions for Use" section, please add a comma (,) between the words "flies" and "mosquitoes."
2. In the use directions for "Termites" please add the following sentence:

"The termite application is not intended as a substitute for mechanical alteration, soil treatment or foundation treatment, but merely a supplement to kill workers or winged reproductive forms which may be present in the treated channels and spaces at the time of treatment."

3. In the section for "Imported Fire Ants," the sentence which is stated as, "Space injection...in the center" is unclear. Please add the following use directions for fire ant mounds which may enable the consumer to visualize the application procedure.

"Visually divide mounds into four quadrants and the mound center. Probe insertions and treatment should be made in the center of each quadrant and the center of each mound."

4. Please delete the sentence which is stated as, "Do not...on plants" and replace it with the following statement:

"Do not use as a space spray."

5. In the "Note To Physician" section, please separate the words, "lavage" and "is."

The word "undertake" is one word. Please revise this accordingly.

6. In the container disposal statement, after the word "container," and before the word "and" please add the following phrase:

"in several layers of newspaper."

Please submit five (5) copies of final printed labeling reflecting the changes listed above before your product is released for shipment. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To operate: Holding the can upright, with orifice directed toward surface to be treated, press actuator button.

To kill: Cockroaches, Spiders, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Earwigs: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

To kill: Brown Dog Ticks: apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

To control Flies Mosquitoes: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray out side surfaces of windows and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

For use in In edible Product Areas of Meat Packing and Food Processing Plants. Any exposed food products, equipment or packing materials must be removed or covered before spraying. Equipment and utensils in Federally inspected meat and poultry plants must be washed with an acceptable detergent and rinsed with potable water to remove all traces of contamination. Application of this product in food areas of food-handling establishments, other than as a crack and crevice treatment, is not permitted.

Localized treatment of wood destroying insects: CARPENTER ANTS, CARPENTER BEES AND TERMITES. Locate source of infestation. Inject 5-10 seconds spray into insect tunnels and cavities. For Carpenter Bees, seal entrance openings with small pieces of stainless steel wool after spray application.

IMPORTED FIRE ANTS: To treat mounds use the Nationwide 12 inch soil injector. To maximize spray distribution insert into the mound full length if possible. Inject the mound at 3-6 sites at a rate of 5-10 seconds spray per site. For very large mounds (over 36" diameter) increase the number of injection sites. Space injection sites in a circular pattern on the mound surface with one site in the center. To quiet active ants on the surface, sweep surface with spray from a distance of 18 inches. For best results, apply in cool weather 65-80°F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS ANIMALS

CAUTION

Do not allow children or pets to come in contact with this product until spray has dried. Do not spray on plants. Apply as a surface spray only. Do not allow spray to contact water supplies. Thoroughly wash cooking utensils contaminated with this product and cover fish bowls before spraying. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Keep away from food, feed and water supplies. Do not smoke while using. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Consult a physician immediately.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICES

IF SWALLOWED: do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. Do not take petroleum solvent. Call a physician immediately.

IF INHALED: remove victim to fresh air. Call a physician if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician for attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN. Contains piperonyl butoxide. Gastric lavage is deemed necessary if ingestion is recent. Proper placement of cuffed endotracheal tube is essential. Ingredients contain a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine may be used.

CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat and open flame. Do not puncture or burn. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause leakage.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in newspaper for trash collection.
