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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To operate: Holding the can upright, with orifice directed toward surface to be treated, press actuator button. Use as a spot treatment on localized surfaces only.

To kill: **Cockroaches, Spiders, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Earwigs:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

To kill: **Brown Dog Ticks:** apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

To control **Flies, Mosquitoes:** Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of windows and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

For use in **Edible Product Areas of Meat Packing and Food Processing Plants.** Any exposed food products, equipment or packing materials must be removed or covered before spraying. Equipment and utensils in Federally inspected meat and poultry plants must be washed with an acceptable detergent and rinsed with potable water to remove all traces of contamination. Application of this product in food areas of food-handling establishments, other than as a crack and crevice treatment, is not permitted.

Localized treatment of wood destroying insects: CARPENTER ANTS, CARPENTER BEES AND TERMITES. Locate source of infestation. Inject 5-10 seconds spray into insect tunnels and cavities. For Carpenter Bees, seal entrance openings with small pieces of stainless steel wool after spray application. The termite application is not intended as a substitute for mechanical alteration, soil treatment or foundation treatment, but merely a supplemental to kill workers or winged reproductive forms which may be present in the treated channels and spaces at the time of treatment.

IMPORTED FIRE ANTS: To treat mounds use the Nationwide 12 inch soil injector. To maximize spray distribution insert into the mound full length if possible. Inject the mound at 3-6 sites at a rate of 5-10 seconds spray per site. For very large mounds (over 36" diameter) increase the number of injection sites. Space injection, visually divide mounds into four quadrants and the

mound center. Probe insertions and treat the center of each quadrant and the mound. To quiet active ants on the surface with spray from a distance of 18 inches. Apply in cool weather 65-80°F, or in early evening hours. Treat new mounds as they

Do not allow children or pets to contact until spray has dried. Do not use as a surface spray only as specified or allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handlers with this product. Remove pet bowls before spraying. Avoid contact with clothing. Avoid breathing vapors of spray from food, feedstuffs and domestic water. Wash thoroughly while using. Wash thoroughly if swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL USE

IF SWALLOWED: do not induce vomiting. Call a physician at once. **IF INHALED:** remove victim to fresh air and call a physician if indicated. **IF ON SKIN:** remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected areas with soap and water. **IF IN EYES:** flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician for attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum solvent. Gastric lavage is deemed necessary, if proper placement of cuffed endotracheal tube. Ingredients contain a cholinesterase inhibitor. Symptomatically Atropine is an antidote.

CHEMICAL HAZARDS FLAMMABLE

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause leakage.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in layers of newspaper and put in trash can.
