DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Operate: Hold container upright. Spray surfaces only until wet.

COCKROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES: Spray baseboards and other places where insects hide. Spray surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, other localized areas infested with them. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants until surfaces are completely dry.

BOOKCLOUSE & SILVERFISH: Spray boards, door frames, bookcases and other surfaces in these locations where possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

GRAIN WEEVILS, FLOUR BEETLES, STORE BEETLES: In exposed areas, spray stages of infestation. **BOXELDER BUGS, ELMLEAF BEETLES, CLOVERMITES:** Contact as many areas as possible such as cracks and crevices, door frames, under siding in machinery, etc. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray window and door frames, wall cracks, etc. Repeat in localized areas of floors and floor coverings as infestations warrant and as recommended in animal quarters following formulation.

FLEAS, ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CRICKETS, MILLIPEDES: For treatment of insects in areas where these insects hide, spray areas thoroughly. Repeat treatment as necessary.

WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOWJACKETS: Spray dark when all the insects have returned. Hold at arm's length and depress button. Repeat as necessary.

Localized treatment of wood destruction. **CARPENTER ANTS, CARPENTER BEES:** For infestation, inject 5-10 seconds spray extension tube provided. For Carpenter Bees, use small pieces of stainless steel wool.

APPLICATION WITHIN FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS: Limited to crack and crevice treatment. Do not apply amount of material directly into cracks between different elements of construction, the floor, wall voids, motor housing, or hollow equipment legs where insect infestation is suspected. Avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces. Avoid contamination of exposed food products, equipment, or covered before spraying. Equipment and poultry plants must be pre-rinsed with potable water to remove residue.
