CAUTION

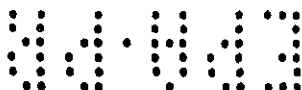
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: This Concentrate is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers which give particle size of aerosol size, such as the LECO Mini ULY or Micro-Gen Micron Generator. It can be diluted with refined kerosenes which meet Food Additive Regulation 121.1182 and can be applied in fogging equipment that gives larger than aerosol particle size, such as the Microsol or Challenger machines. It can also be diluted with oil specified above and applied as a contact spray to kill crawling insects shown later on this label.

Space Spray - Undiluted in Aerosol Generators - to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 1 oz. of undiluted Concentrate per 1000 cu. ft. of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Do not apply this undiluted spray in facilities operating under USDA poultry, meat, rabbit and egg products inspection program.

Space Spray - Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment - to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute Concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 29 parts of oil and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fl. oz. dilute spray (0.4 gal) per 25,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct fog upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling area. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.
