DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: Use Residual Spray from EVERCIDE® Intermediate 2274 as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

For Spot Treatment:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs and Carpet Beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product.

For Crack and Crevice:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, and Carpet Beetles: Apply diluted spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevice: Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
