CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Do not apply directly to food. 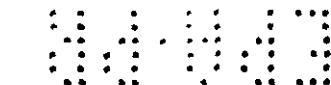
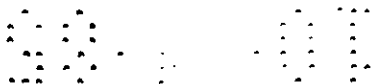
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IN FOGGING EQUIPMENT AND HAND SPRAYERS

To Kill Accessible Stages of Insects Infesting Dried Fruit Products in Storage or Being Processed: Close room or warehouse and shut off all ventilating systems. Dispense this product as a fine mist in the air above trays or shelves of dried fruit. Use a spraying device similar to the Microsol machine or use fixed ceiling sprayers that produce a very fine spray. Do not apply to fruit directly. If overhead sprayers are used, be sure that the spray is discharged from a position of at least 6 feet over the top trays of fruit. Use a dosage of 1 gallon of this spray per 50,000 cubic feet of room space. Repeat applications as necessary for insect control, but do not exceed more than ten applications at this dosage in any given month. More than ten applications may also be made if this spray is diluted with more petroleum distillate so that the pyrethrins and synergists in the final spray are reduced proportionately. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after the treatment is completed. Maximum dilution is 1 part F-1353 plus 5.6 parts oil.
