PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In food handling areas application is limited to crack and crevice treatment. Do not apply directly to food or feedstuffs. In commercial food handling areas, application to food processing equipment during application. Do not use in the home.
